It is the philosophy of the Board, under the mandate of the Education Asstablish, and set guidelines, regulations, and procedures for the registration and admission of students to our schools in a fair and equitable manner. Administrative regulations will be maintained and will reflect the philosophy of this policy.

Non-Resident Students

For the purpose of this policy, notesidents are visa students, students from out country, and others for whom the Boardarges a fee.

It is the policy of the Board to admit to its schools, subject to space availability, non resident students, with appropriate fees (see Student Tuition Fees Section), supporting documentation where applicable (see Legal Guardianship Section under the guidelines of any education agreements, as permissible under the Education Act

2. First Nation Students – Living on a First Nation Territory

First Nation students living on a First Nation Territary welcomed into the Board' schools through tuition agreements. Fee payments to the Board for these students are determined through the tuition agreements established collaboratively between the Board

Students living in the Board'jurisdiction, whose parent(s)/guardian(s) are waiting for landed immigrant status and/or residency, will be admitted to school without a charge of fees in accordance with direction from the Ministry of Education.

4. Permanent Resident Students

Students, living with their family in Ontarionho havebeen granted permanent resident status Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canadall beadmitted to school without payment of fees.

Student Tuition Fees

The Regulations under the Education Activide for a calculation of tuition fees designed to cover the cost of education on a per pupil basis. In accordance with the Act, the Board will charge tuition fees to cover education costs for excident students.

It is the policy of the Board thatdministration establish the student tuition fees and prepare a report annually for presentation to Administrative Council for the upcoming school year.

Requests to waive fees should be submitted in writing to the appropriate superintendent of student acceptance of student acceptance

6. Legal Guardianship

Section 1 of the Education Adefines a guardian as a person who has lawful custody of a child, other than the parent of a child.

It is the policy of the Boral that legal guardianship must be provided at time of registration by any person who is the more of a student of compulsory school age.
