1. Video Recording of passengers while riding
In this process, the following guidelines are provided.

This policy in no way supersedes other existing disciplinary
procedures, rather, it may be used to assist in the determination
of unacceptable behaviour.

Video recording equipment used on contracted buses must
be provided by Transportation Services Central Ontario (STSCO).

Each bus is provided with a quantity of video boxes, which they may
be used by the operator on selected vehicles.

The distribution of video cameras and related equipment
is the responsibility of the operator.

Video boxes and related equipment provided by STSCO

as applicable, will be installed as required by the bus

Video boxes shall be used for general viewing or driver training
at the request of the operator or principal of STSCO

Video boxes may be used in ascertaining a student discipline problem
by the principal/vice-principal, STSCO staff and/or operator.

Video boxes may be used during investigation by principals, vice-principals,
and/or STSCO staff. This policy is subject to all regulations outlined in the Municipal Freedom
of Information and Access to Information Act and the Protection of Privacy Act
